SAUL: "KING KNOW-IT-ALL" Part 1

1 Samuel 9:26 & 10:1,9 — They rose about daybreak, and Samuel called to Saul on the roof, "Get ready, and I will send you on your way." When Saul got ready, he and Samuel went outside together. ²⁷ As they were going down to the edge of the town, Samuel said to Saul, "Tell the servant to go on ahead of us"—and the servant did so—"but you stay here for a while, so that I may give you a message from God." Then Samuel took a flask of olive oil and poured it on Saul's head and kissed him, saying, "Has not the LORD anointed you ruler over his inheritance?"

⁹ As Saul turned to leave Samuel, God changed Saul's heart, and all these signs were fulfilled that day.

1 Samuel 8:7 — And the LORD told him: "Listen to all that the people are saying to you; it is not you they have rejected, but they have rejected me as their king."

When GOD anointed Saul to be the King, He wasn't anointing him for EVERYTHING

1 Corinthians 3:6,7 — I planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God has been making it grow.

⁷ So neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God, who makes things grow.

Just because YOU'RE anointed for what you're doing, doesn't mean you're anointed for what I'M doing.

DISOBEDIENCE is a "Know-It-All's" way of saying... "My way is better than God's way."

1 Samuel 15:20,21

"But I did obey the LORD," Saul said. "I went on the mission the LORD assigned me. I completely destroyed the Amalekites and brought back Agag their king."

²¹ The soldiers took sheep and cattle from the plunder, the best of what was devoted to God, in order to sacrifice them to the LORD your God at Gilgal."

1 Samuel 15:22,23 — But Samuel replied:

"Does the LORD delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices as much as in obeying the LORD?"

To obey is better than sacrifice,
and to heed is better than the fat of rams.

²³ For rebellion is like the sin of divination,
and arrogance like the evil of idolatry.

Because you have rejected the word of the LORD,
he has rejected you as king."

A "Know-It-All" will break every rule to keep their POSITION
