**1 Corinthians 12:4-11** – There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit distributes them. <sup>5</sup> There are different kinds of service, but the same Lord. <sup>6</sup> There are different kinds of working, but in all of them and in everyone it is the same God at work.

Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good. <sup>8</sup> To one there is given through the Spirit a message of wisdom, to another a message of knowledge by means of the same Spirit, <sup>9</sup> to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by that one Spirit, <sup>10</sup> to another miraculous powers, to another prophecy, to another distinguishing between spirits, to another speaking in different kinds of tongues, and to still another the interpretation of tongues. <sup>11</sup> All these are the work of one and the same Spirit, and he distributes them to each one, just as he determines.

### The first Vocal Gift in 1 Corinthians 12 is “TONGUES”

**Genesis 11:6** – The LORD said, “If as one people speaking the same language they have begun to do this, then nothing they plan to do will be impossible for them.

We believe that tongues are the initial indicator that you have been baptized in the Holy Spirit, because tongues take the least amount of faith to receive, since they cannot be intelligently judged.

### The second Vocal Gift in 1 Corinthians 12 is the “INTERPRETATION of TONGUES”

**1 Corinthians 14:27-28** – If anyone speaks in a tongue, two—or at the most three—should speak, one at a time, and someone must interpret. <sup>28</sup> If there is no interpreter, the speaker should keep quiet in the church and speak to himself and to God.

**Daniel 5:25-28** –

“This is the inscription that was written:

MENE, MENE, TEKEL, PARSIN

<sup>26</sup> “Here is what these words mean:

Mene: God has numbered the days of your reign and brought it to an end.

<sup>27</sup> Tekel: You have been weighed on the scales and found wanting.

<sup>28</sup> Peres: Your kingdom is divided and given to the Medes and Persians.”

### The third Vocal Gift in 1 Corinthians 12 is “PROPHECY”

**1 Corinthians 14:1-5** – Follow the way of love and eagerly desire gifts of the Spirit, especially prophecy. <sup>2</sup> For anyone who speaks in a tongue does not speak to people but to God. Indeed, no one understands them; they utter mysteries by the Spirit.

<sup>3</sup> But the one who prophesies speaks to people for their strengthening, encouraging and comfort. <sup>4</sup> Anyone who speaks in a tongue edifies themselves, but the one who prophesies edifies the church. <sup>5</sup> I would like every one of you to speak in tongues, but I would rather have you prophesy. The one who prophesies is greater than the one who speaks in tongues, unless someone interprets, so that the church may be edified.

**Romans 8:26,27** – In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us through wordless groans. And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for God’s people in accordance with the will of God.
