## “THIS IS NOW” Part 2

**Acts 2:32-38** – God has raised this Jesus to life, and we are all witnesses of it. <sup>33</sup> Exalted to the right hand of God, he has received from the Father the promised Holy Spirit and has poured out what you now see and hear. <sup>34</sup> For David did not ascend to heaven, and yet he said,

“The Lord said to my Lord:

“Sit at my right hand

<sup>35</sup> until I make your enemies  
a footstool for your feet.”

<sup>36</sup> “Therefore let all Israel be assured of this: God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Messiah.”

<sup>37</sup> When the people heard this, they were cut to the heart and said to Peter and the other apostles, “Brothers, what shall we do?”

<sup>38</sup> Peter replied, “Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Once you have been filled with The Holy Spirit you will know what to do

Church, there is a difference between Condemnation and Conviction

Condemnation is from Satan and is meant to tear you down because it shows you the problem, but doesn't point to a solution. Conviction is from the Holy Spirit – it is godly sorrow and is what will lead you to repentance. (Romans 2:4)

Condemnation tells you, you are such a failure, look what you did. Conviction tells you come to me and I will FORGIVE you!

*Brothers, What Shall We Do?*

Saul accepted Jesus BEFORE he knew who Jesus was

“Who are You LORD?” Paul asked. (Acts 9:5b)

The Philippian jailer never heard of SALVATION but asked Paul and Silas how he could get it.

“Sirs, What must I do to be SAVED?” (Acts 16:30b)

## 4 LEVELS OF PRAYING IN THE SPIRIT

1. Praying with your mind with understanding. (1 Cor 14:13-15)
2. Praying in the Holy Spirit inspired and instructed with understanding in English. (1 Corinthians 14:13-15)
3. Praying in the Holy Spirit in tongues this is a devotional closest prayer helping our infirmities or cluelessness. (Romans 8:26-27)
4. Such intercessions that no words are adequate just groanings. (Romans 8:26-27)
