THE INFILLING AND BAPTISM OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

Part 3

John 20:19-22 – On the evening of that first day of the week, when the disciples were together, with the doors locked for fear of the Jewish leaders, Jesus came and stood among them and said, “Peace be with you!”²⁰ After he said this, he showed them his hands and side. The disciples were overjoyed when they saw the Lord.

²¹ Again Jesus said, “Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you.”

²² AND WITH THAT HE BREATHED ON THEM AND SAID, “RECEIVE THE HOLY SPIRIT.

ECCLESIOLOGY: The study of the Christian church, the origins of Christianity, its relationship to Jesus and to salvation. All things church.

PNUMATOLOGY: The branch of Christian theology concerned with the HOLY SPIRIT.

GLOSSOLALIA: The act of speaking in other languages or tongues - in languages that are unknown to the speaker.

ESCHATOLOGY: The part of theology concerned with death, judgment and the final destiny of the soul and of humankind.

When Jesus said to His disciples, “RECEIVE THE HOLY SPIRIT” in John 20:22, they experienced SALVATION and at the same time the INFILLING OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

HOLY: Having to do with being set apart or dedicated for service and for worship of the ALMIGHTY GOD

The early Pentecostals called it “The Baptism in the Holy Spirit,” with evidence of speaking in other tongues because they related it to Acts 2:4 which states: All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Holy Spirit enabled them.

You need a language you can pray when you don’t know what to pray. The Scripture says in Romans 8:26&27: “In the same way the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we are to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us through wordless groans. And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for God’s people in accordance with the will of God.”
