Luke 9:57-62 - As they were walking along the road, a man said to him, "I will follow you wherever you go."

- $^{\rm 58}$ Jesus replied, "Foxes have dens and birds have nests, but the Son of Man has no place to lay his head."
 - ⁵⁹ He said to another man, "Follow me."
 - But he replied, "Lord, first let me go and bury my father."
- $^{\rm 60}$ Jesus said to him, "Let the dead bury their own dead, but you go and proclaim the kingdom of God."
- ⁶¹ Still another said, "I will follow you, Lord; but first let me go back and say goodbye to my family."
- ⁶² Jesus replied, "No one who puts a hand to the plow and looks back is fit for service in the kingdom of God."
