**Isaiah 45:1** – This is what the Lord says to his anointed to Cyrus, whose right hand I take hold of to subdue nations before him and to strip kings of their armor, to open doors before him so that gates will not be shut.

**1 Corinthians 2:9 NLT** – That is what the Scriptures mean when they say, “No eye has seen, no ear has heard, and no mind has imagined what God has prepared for those who love him.”

**2 Chronicles 20:22-24,29-30** – As they began to sing and praise, the Lord set ambushes against the men of Ammon and Moab and Mount Seir who were invading Judah, and they were defeated.

<sup>23</sup> The Ammonites and Moabites rose up against the men from Mount Seir to destroy and annihilate them. After they finished slaughtering the men from Seir, they helped to destroy one another.

<sup>24</sup> When the men of Judah came to the place that overlooks the desert and looked toward the vast army, they saw only dead bodies lying on the ground; no one had escaped.

<sup>29</sup> The fear of God came on all the surrounding kingdoms when they heard how the Lord had fought against the enemies of Israel.

<sup>30</sup> And the kingdom of Jehoshaphat was at peace, for his God had given him rest on every side.

## How can I remember that My God is INCREDIBLE?

### Believe the **PROMISES** of God and not the **LIES** of the devil.

**2 Corinthians 1:20** – For no matter how many promises God has made, they are “YES” in Christ. And so through him the “AMEN” is spoken by us to the glory of GOD!

### Focus on the WINS and not the LOSSES

**2 Corinthians 2:14a KJV** – Now thanks be unto God, which ALWAYS causeth us to triumph in Christ!

### Remember to PRAISE the **WORRY** away

**Psalms 34:1-4** – I will extol the Lord at all times; his praise will always be on my lips.

<sup>2</sup> I will glory in the Lord; let the afflicted hear and rejoice.

<sup>3</sup> Glorify the Lord with me; let us exalt his name together.

<sup>4</sup> I sought the Lord, and he answered me; he delivered me from all my fears.

**Acts 16:25-26** – About midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the other prisoners were listening to them. <sup>26</sup> Suddenly there was such a violent earthquake that the foundations of the prison were shaken. At once all the prison doors flew open, and everyone’s chains came loose!

**Jeremiah 17:14** – Heal me, Lord, and I will be healed; save me and I will be saved, for you are the one I praise.

**1 Thessalonians 5:16-18** – Rejoice always, <sup>17</sup> pray continually, <sup>18</sup> give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God’s will for you in Christ Jesus.
