Thought is:



1 Corinthians 2:9 — What no eye has seen, what no ear has heard, and what no human mind has conceived — the things God has prepared for those who love him.

Mark 5:24-34 — So Jesus went with him.

A large crowd followed and pressed around him. ²⁵ And a woman was there who had been subject to bleeding for twelve years. ²⁶ She had suffered a great deal under the care of many doctors and had spent all she had, yet instead of getting better she grew worse. ²⁷ When she heard about Jesus, she came up behind him in the crowd and touched his cloak, ²⁸ because she thought, "If I just touch his clothes, I will be healed." ²⁹ Immediately her bleeding stopped and she felt in her body that she was freed from her suffering.

³⁰ At once Jesus realized that power had gone out from him. He turned around in the crowd and asked, "Who touched my clothes?"

³¹ "You see the people crowding against you," his disciples answered, "and yet you can ask, 'Who touched me?'"

³² But Jesus kept looking around to see who had done it. ³³ Then the woman, knowing what had happened to her, came and fell at his feet and, trembling with fear, told him the whole truth. ³⁴ He said to her, "Daughter, your faith has healed you. Go in peace and be freed from your suffering."

First, This woman expected a miracle every day!

Mark 5:28 — "If I just touch his clothes, I will be healed."

Church, You must "THINK" miracles in order to "EXPECT" a miracle!

Romans 12:1-2 — Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship.

Mark 5:27 — When she heard about Jesus, she came up behind him in the crowd and touched his cloak.

This word TOUCH, in Mark 5:28, comes from a Greek word "hapto" ... which means to fasten to, or to cling to.

The woman with the issue of blood held on to Jesus because she was EXPECTING HER MIRACLE! And she received what she was EXPECTING.
