Thought is: **“GOD’S POWER IS ALWAYS
BIGGER THAN MY PROBLEM!”**

Romans 8:37 (NLT) — “No, despite all these things, overwhelming victory is ours through Christ, who loved us.”

Romans 8:37 (MSG) — None of this fazes us because Jesus loves us.”

Joshua 2:1-24 (Condensed, The Message) — Story of Rahab, The Prostitute

¹ Joshua son of Nun secretly sent two men from Shittim as spies: “Go. Look over the land. Check out Jericho.” They left and arrived at the house of a harlot named Rahab and stayed there.

² The king of Jericho was told, “Men from Israel have come to spy out the land.”

³ The king sent word to Rahab: “Bring out the men who came to you. They’re here to spy.”

⁴ The woman had taken the two men and hidden them. She said, “Yes, men did come... but I didn’t know where they’d come from. When it was dark, they left... I don’t know where they went. Hurry, you might catch them!” ⁶ (She had actually taken them up on the roof and hidden them under stalks of flax.)

⁸ Before the spies were down for the night, she came up to them on the roof

⁹ and said, “I know that God has given you the land. We’re all afraid. Everyone in the country feels hopeless. ¹⁰ We’ve heard how God dried up the Red Sea for you ... and what you did to the two Amorite kings—Sihon and Og—whom you put under a holy curse and destroyed. ¹¹ We heard it and our hearts sank ... God, your God, is God of all the heavens above and earth below.

¹² Now promise me by God: I showed you mercy—show my family mercy. ¹³ Spare my father and mother, my brothers and sisters—everyone connected with my family.”

¹⁴ The men said, “Our lives for yours! But don’t tell anyone what we’re doing. When God gives us the land, we’ll treat you kindly.”

¹⁵ She lowered them out a window with a rope ... her house was on the city wall. ¹⁶ She told them, “Head for the hills ... hide there for three days until they return. Then go on your way.”

¹⁷ The men said, “We’ll be bound by our oath ... ¹⁸ when we invade the land, tie this scarlet cord in the window. Gather your family inside. ¹⁹ Anyone outside your house is on their own ... but anyone with you will be safe. ²⁰ If you tell anyone what we’re doing, we’re free from our oath.”

²¹ She said, “If that’s what you say, that’s how it will be.” She sent them off and tied the scarlet cord in the window.

²² They headed for the hills and stayed there three days. The men chasing them gave up.

²³ The spies returned, came down from the hills, and told Joshua everything. ²⁴ They said, “Yes! God has given the whole country to us. Everybody’s afraid.”

Joshua 5:10-15 (MSG) — The people of Israel continued to camp at Gilgal. They celebrated the Passover ... in the plains of Jericho.

Right after Passover, the very next day...

Joshua was near Jericho. He looked up and saw right in front of him a man standing, holding his drawn sword.

Joshua stepped up to him and said, “Whose side are you on—ours or our enemies’?”

He said, “Neither. I’m commander of God’s army. I’ve just arrived.” Joshua fell, face to the ground, and worshiped. He asked, “What orders does my Master have for his servant?”

God’s army commander ordered Joshua, “Take your sandals off your feet. The place you are standing is holy.”

Joshua did it.

Joshua 2:9,11 — She said: “I know the Lord has given you this land... the Lord your God is God in heaven above and on the earth below.”

Hebrews 11:31 (MSG) — “By an act of faith, Rahab, the Jericho harlot, welcomed the spies and escaped the destruction that came on those who refused to trust God.”
