## “I'M ALWAYS READY!”

**2 Timothy 2:4** — Preach the word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage — with great patience, and careful instruction.

**Psalm 37:23 NLT** — The Lord directs the steps of the godly. He delights in every detail of their lives.

## “I'M ALWAYS READY!”

### 1<sup>st</sup> The “I’m Always Ready” person pushes back on BOREDOM!

**Mark 16:15** — He said to them, “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation.

**Ecclesiastes 9:10** — Whatever your hand finds to do—do it with all your might.

**Colossians 3:17** — And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God, the father through him.

**Proverbs 19:15** — Laziness brings on deep sleep, and the shiftless go hungry.

### 2<sup>nd</sup> The “I’m Always Ready” Man OR Woman of God keeps their HEART, MIND, and SPIRIT FREE of IMPURE THOUGHTS!

**Ephesians 5:11-16** — Have nothing to do with the fruitless deeds of darkness, but rather expose them. <sup>12</sup> It is shameful even to mention what the disobedient do in secret. <sup>13</sup> But everything exposed by the light becomes visible—and everything that is illuminated becomes a light. <sup>14</sup> This is why it is said:

“Wake up, sleeper,  
rise from the dead,  
and Christ will shine on you.”

<sup>15</sup> Be very careful, then, how you live—not as unwise but as wise, <sup>16</sup> making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil.

### 3<sup>rd</sup> The “I’m Always Ready” person — is not driven by FEAR but by the IMPOSSIBLE!

**Job 42:2** — Job said ... I know that you can do all things; No purpose of yours can be thwarted.

**Jeremiah 32:17** — Jeremiah the prophet said ... Ah, Sovereign, Lord, You have made the heavens and the Earth by your great power and outstretched arm. Nothing is too hard for you.

**Mark 10:27** — Jesus looked at them, and said, “With man, this is impossible, but not with God; all things are possible with God.”

**Romans 8:31** — St. Paul said ... What, then, shall we say in response to these things? If God is for us, who could be against us?
